## Important instructions

(Please read before placing your orders)

This catalog will help you sell more Fenton glass. Please use it to place your orders between calls by the Fenton salesman. We hope that you will let this be the salesman's assistant and that this catalog will serve you well.

Each shape and pattern offered by Fenton is pictured here. Some pieces are made in several colors. The price list or the order blank will list every item and the colors made. Please refer to the color code on this page.



## Easier receiving and pricing

The ware number, color code, and description are shown on the price list and on the invoice. Each box is marked with a pressure sensitive label showing the Fenton ware number, color code and suggested EASTERN retail price. If you wish, as you unpack each piece, the pressure sensitive label can be taken from the box and stuck to the ware. It is then properly priced.

(NOTE: Accounts located west of the Rockies should only use this label to identify and check in the shipment. Refer to the Western Retail Price List for the suggested retail price of each item.)



ROUTING OF SHIPMENTS—Unless otherwise specified by you, all shipments will be routed the best way available.

CLAIMS FOR DAMAGE IN TRANSIT—All of our shipments are carefully packed by experienced packers in strict accordance with packing methods approved by the various carriers. Should there be breakage or loss in transit, the carrier is liable, and neither you nor The Fenton Art Glass Company is required to suffer a loss. It is necessary, however, that you report such damage to the carrier and request an inspection report from them showing the extent of the loss. This inspection report becomes the basis for your claim which should be filed promptly. If you require assistance in filing the claim we will be glad to help

Should there be damage in a Parcel Post shipment, it is advisable to report the damage to your local postmaster, but do not file the claim. Send a detailed description of the damaged merchandise along with our invoice number. Upon receipt of this information, we will arrange to replace the damaged merchandise and will handle the claim for the replacement cost.

DISCONTINUED ITEMS-Please do not include in your order any items which do not appear on our current price list and order blank. We frequently drop less popular pieces to make room for new items in our various lines. Numbers which have been discontinued are then no longer available, and cannot be shipped.


